Getting to Philly

- Philadelphia, the second-largest city on the East Coast, boasts a vibrant downtown (Center City) and is easily accessible from anywhere in the U.S.
- Located in the heart of the Northeast Corridor, it's just 80 miles from New York City, 120 miles from Washington, D.C., and 55 miles from the New Jersey shore.
- With nearly 25% of the U.S. population within a six-hour drive, Philadelphia offers award-winning restaurants, world-class arts, and the nation's most historic square mile. It is also an established pharma hub for the Americas region.
- Prefer not to drive? Amtrak, Greyhound, and Megabus connect Philly to major cities, while Philadelphia International Airport (PHL) provides flights to over 130 destinations worldwide.





You can walk to the Pennsylvania Convention Center if you book your hotel with *OnPeak* and if you stay after you can continue to enjoy Philadelphia on foot.

Philly offers a variety of eco-friendly, convenient ways to explore its historic sites, vibrant neighborhoods, and top attractions – no car required.





Philadelphia is one of the most walkable cities in the U.S., with:

- A compact downtown (Center City) featuring a simple street grid.
- Scenic walking trails along the
 Schuylkill River and Delaware River.
- Iconic public squares like *Rittenhouse* and *Logan Square*, perfect for breaks between sights.


Look for *Walk! Philadelphia* directional signs and uniformed Community Service Representatives (CSRs) throughout the city to help you navigate.





With over 340 miles of bike lanes & trails, Philadelphia is perfect for cyclists.

- Use the *Indego Bike Share* program for easy, short-term rentals starting at \$4.50 per ride.
- Bikes are available 24/7 at 250+ docking stations across the city.



Getting Around Philadelphia

PHLASH Downtown Loop

The colorful *PHLASH* buses are an affordable way to explore the city:

- \$2 per ride or \$5 for an all-day pass.
- Operates seasonally, with daily service in May.





SEPTA Public Transit



Philadelphia's public transportation system, *SEPTA*, connects the city and surrounding counties with subways, buses, trolleys, and trains. It's affordable, accessible, and bike-friendly. Key options include:

- Broad Street Line (subway): Convenient for getting around Center City
- Regional Rail: For trips to neighborhoods like Chestnut Hill & Manayunk



Car Options








Sustainability Matters
