## India-EU Free Trade Agreement:

Signed on 27 January 2026, the India-European Union Free Trade Agreement is the biggest of its kind, impacting around 25% of international GDP. Two decades in the making, it is set to double the amount of goods and services exported from the EU to India and reduce tariffs by upwards of 90%.

CPHI & PMEC India gives exhibitors and visitors from the EU their first chance to take advantage of the agreement's benefits, including:

- Easier access to the Indian pharma market
- Greater safeguards around IP
- Speedier exports thanks to simplified customs processes

This will be the first edition of CPHI & PMEC India since the India-EU FTA was signed and looks set to usher in a new era of frictionless trade and cross-border collaboration between the two regions' pharma sectors.

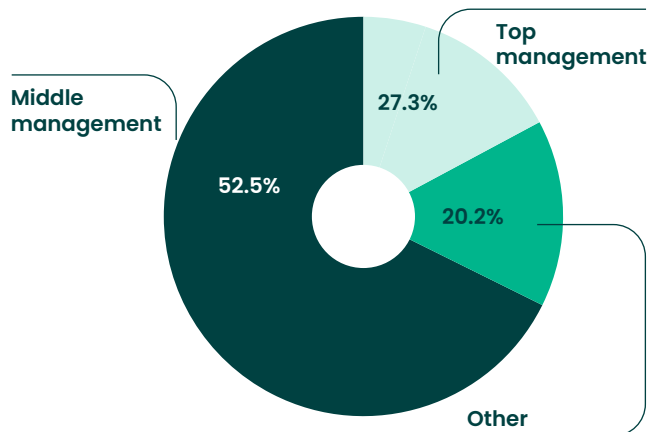

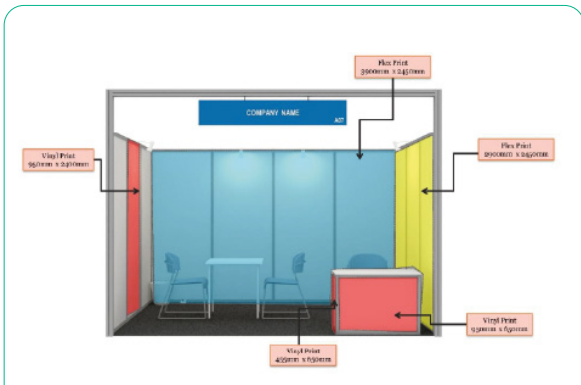

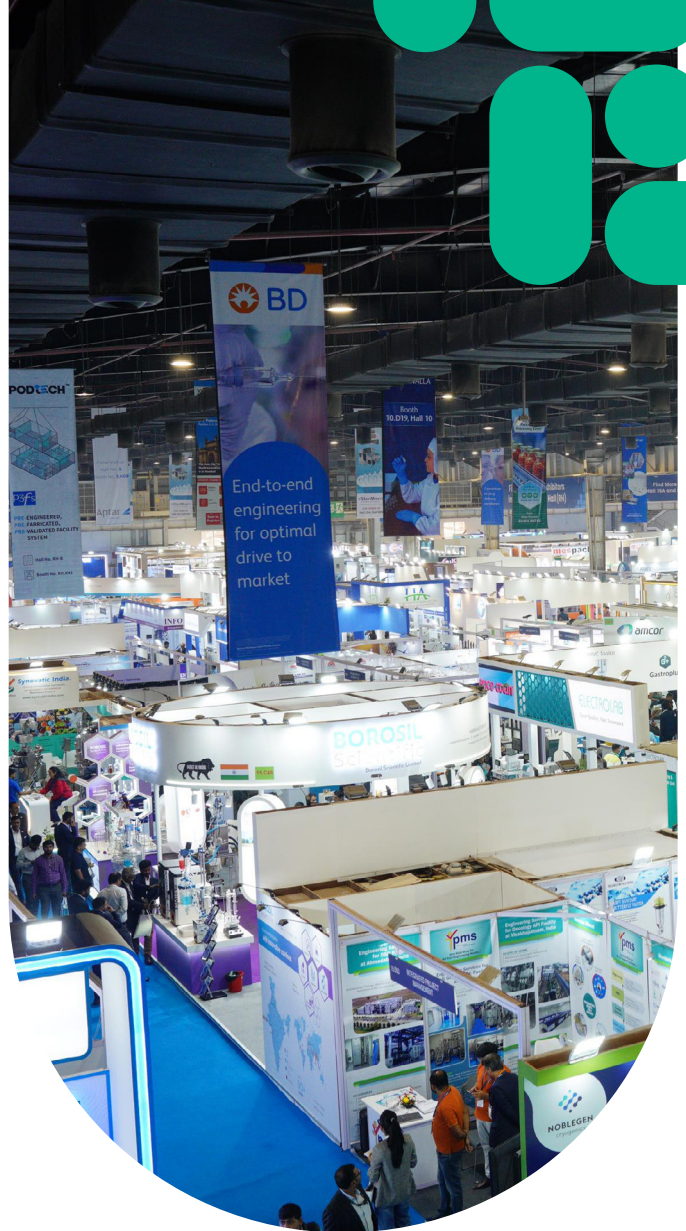

- Only LED lights of not more than 100 Watts may be used.

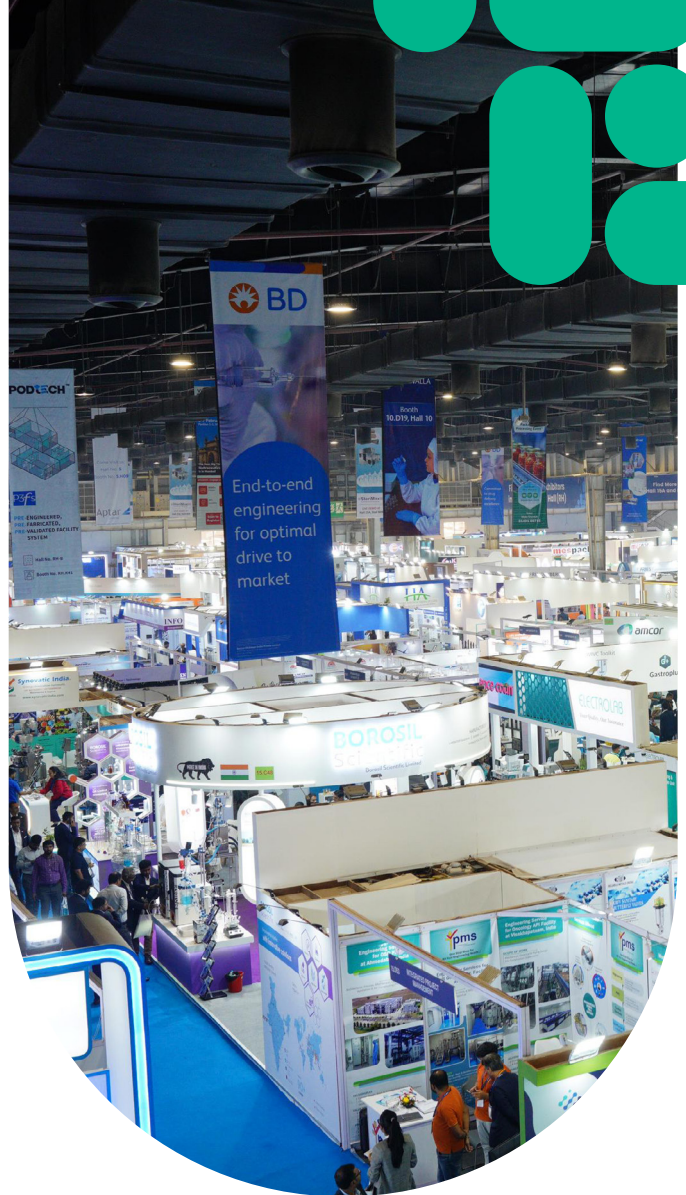

- Woodwork or wooden flooring is strictly not allowed.
- Do not drill, nail, perforate, tack down, staple or cause any damage to the stand panels.
- In case of violation, the official shell scheme stand agency will be obliged to request payment for any damage caused at the rate of INR 2,500.00 per panel.
- Only LED lights of not more than 100 Watts may be used for Schell scheme and bare space stalls.
