


## Visitors' main areas of interest\*\*





## Why is CPHI & PMEC India being hosted at two separate venues in 2026?

For 2026, CPHI & PMEC India will be hosted across **two world-class venues** to provide a more focused and seamless experience for all attendees.

- **CPHI India: Focus on ingredients, APIs, formulations, and chemicals.**
- **PMEC India: Focus on pharma machinery, packaging, Lab & Analytical equipment, and Cleanroom technology.**

The event's growth has led to this expansion, offering more space, better flow, and stronger networking. Dedicated zones now let visitors explore their focus areas with greater ease.

## Will I be able to visit both venues?

Absolutely! Visitors can attend **both events**, your badge will be valid for entry at **both locations**.

To make it convenient, **regular shuttle services** will run between **IICC (Dwarka)** and **IEML (Greater Noida)** during overlapping days (24–25 November 2026).

## How many days will the event run?

The event will take place over **four days** to allow ample time for visitors to explore both venues:

- **CPHI India: 23–25 November 2026**
- **PMEC India: 24–26 November 2026**

This extended format ensures more time for networking, meetings, and knowledge sharing.

## Will splitting the event affect its experience or identity?

Not at all! The split enhances the overall visitor experience. While the venues are separate, **CPHI & PMEC India remain one unified platform** representing the entire pharmaceutical value chain.

The two-day overlap ensures visitors can connect across both segments, ingredients and machinery.

## How can I travel between the two venues?

We'll provide **free shuttle services** between **IICC (Dwarka)** and **IEML (Greater Noida)** on the overlapping days for visitors who wish to attend both events. Additionally, both venues are connected via the **Delhi Metro**.

## How far are the venues from each other?

**IICC (Dwarka)** and **IEML (Greater Noida)** are approximately **60 km apart** and connected via the Delhi Metro. **Regular shuttle services** will operate between the venues on overlapping days for smooth travel.
